The Institute has also undertaken the following service and welfare activities for serving the population at large. These services are as follows:-

1. Oral Cancer Detection Programme.
2. Adopting 2 Community & Primary Health Centres of Govt. of Pondicherry.
3. School Dental Health Programmes covering the Union Territory.
4. Organising dental camps in the entire Union Territory and adjoining territories of Tamil Nadu.

Complete dental care solution is being provided to the patients in various departments at free of cost. 146 dental chairs with attached units, specialized X-ray diagnostic modalities such as Orthopantomogram and Cephalometric radiography, Hi-tech prosthodontic labs, with ceramic fabrication facility are available for treatment. Dental surgeries and Maxillafacial surgeries are carried out in the Minor Operation theatres. Casualty service is functioning 24 hours.

Various speciality treatment undertaken are as follows:-

- a) Maxillo-facial prostheses.
- b) Fixed Partial Denture Prostheses/Implant.
- c) Endodontics.
- d) Orthodontic appliances(removable and fixed).
- e) Major & minor Surgeries.
- f) Oral Cancer Screening programme.
- g) Comprehensive dental care for children.

Out-patient treatments and in-patient treatments are also provided for the general patients in the department of General Medicine and General Surgery. 50 bedded Hospital service is available for delivering better patient care. Surgical treatments are provided in the Major Operation Theatre by the General Surgery department.

The college has sophisticated equipments, dental chairs and units, specialized X-ray machine (OPG & Cephalostat) of latest technology and a Hi-Tech Prosthodontics Lab with the state-of-the art equipments at a total cost of ₹70.00 lakhs.

The departments of General Medicine and Surgery are managing the day- to- day needs in the OPD, emergencies, in-patient management and teaching the medical & surgical wards. Special Clinics for diabetic, cardiac and hypertensive patients are functioning within the college premises.


### Academic Achievement and Awards

The Staff and students of this Institution are encouraged to participate in National Conferences and International Conferences. During the year 2018 – 19 totally **108 members attended** the National Conferences, Seminars and Symposiums. Out of this, **75 papers were presented** at National level from this Institution and **16 papers were adjudged as the Best papers** at National level and were awarded.

At present, **40 Scientific Projects** are underway at various stages. **30 Papers were published** in various National and International Journals during this period.
