THE CHAIRMAN WELCOMED THE MEMBERS AND THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AND DISCUSSED THE POINTS DETAILED BELOW.

ITEM NO 1 AND 2:CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE 49TH
AND 50TH MEETING OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS AND ACTION
TAKEN

The Board confirmed the minutes of the 49th and 50th meeting and noted the action taken. The chairman suggested that status of action taken may be submitted in the next meeting in respect of the Agenda items where action taken was still underway.

ITEM NO.3: FIRST RANK IN ALL INDIA NEET MDS 2018 IS SECURED BY A
STUDENT OF MGPGI

The Board noted and congratulated the student, for her achievement.

ITEM NO.4:AMENDMENT TO PERMIT OTHER INSTITUTION STUDENTS TO PURSUE 1 YEAR COMPULSORY INTERNSHIP(CRRI) AT MGPGI

The Dean informed that other institution student can avail internship in the MGPGI with the approval of Dental Council of India. He gave example of Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences which permits other institution students to apply and do their internship there.

On being asked, why other institution students could not get admission in MGPGI on merit should be allowed to do part of their degree course in MGPGI, The Dean informed that such permission for internship is limited to availability of vacancy in internship strength and subject to payment of fee and approval of DCI etc.,. It was noted that Pondicherry students from MINDS, MAHE want to do internship in MGPGI because they save on expenses and get better practical exposure, apart from being near to their native place. Board felt that there should be adequate amount of fee for allowing such internship. This should act as check on private institution to off load their student to MGPGI for internship on one hand and enable the institute to earn income in providing opportunity to do internship. The Dean, MGPGI informed that annual expenditure incurred by the student of MINDS during internship will be about ` 36,000/ to ` 40,000/-.

The Board discussed at length and resolved to permit other institution students to undergo 1 year compulsory internship (CRRI) at Mahatma Gandhi Postgraduate Institute of Dental Sciences subject to availability of vacancy at MGPGI and payment of fee of ` 36,000/- for the said period. This will be further subject to necessary NOC from the concerned college, Pondicherry University and Dental Council of India. The Board also directed that the vacancies in internship be published at the beginning of the session on the pattern of Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences and candidates may be selected for internship based on the merit in the BDS University course.

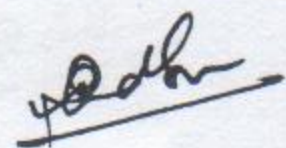
ITEM NO. 5: REQUEST FOR TIMELY RELEASE OF GRANTS IN AID AND ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR STARTING TWO MORE NEW POSTGRADUATE COURSES FROM 2019-2020

The Board noted and requested to send all details of fund required on file.

As regards funds for two new postgraduate courses, the Board requested to put up in detail the expenses involved and income likely to be generated with the start of new PG courses.

ITEM NO.6:DECISION FOR PAYMENT OF FEE FOR SUPREME COURT CASE

The Board discussed at length and resolved that the amount vetted by the Law Department as reasonable may be released.



ITEM NO.7:SERVICE MATTER OF DR.S.P.K. KENNEDY BABU PRESENTED TO THE BOARD AS DIRECTED BY NATIONAL SC COMMISSION

Dr. S.P.K Kennedy Babu had sent a petition to the National Commission for Schedule Castes. The NCSC decided that the petitioner Dr. S.P.K. Kennedy Babu has to submit his appeal to the Governing Board for his case of promotion with retrospective effect from 2003 for consideration. Accordingly Dr. S.P.K. Kennedy Babu submitted his appeal.

The Board noted that the matter of Dr. S.P.K. Kennedy Babu, Professor was taken up before the 48th meeting of the Board of Governor held on 25.10.2015. The Board resolved and requested the Dean to examine and put up the fact on the file. Accordingly the service matter was placed before the DPC. The DPC after going through all the fact and details concluded that the demand of Dr. Kennedy Babu cannot be considered.

After careful consideration of appeal and going through the fact, the Board noted the following:

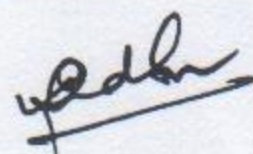
In the years 2003-2005 the post of Professor was advertised for PH category for the specialty of Periodontics by Direct Recruitment only, based on the JUDGEMENT & ORDER dated 11.02.2003 IN THE COURT OF CHIEF COMMISSIONER FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES, so Dr. S.P.K. Kennedy Babu could not be considered for the said post under PH category as he did not belong to PH category. Further the post was meant for selection through direct recruitment on All India Basis. During that period promotion scheme was not in vogue. Further, it is presumptuous for anyone to claim that one must have succeeded in this selection process and therefore has right for appointment with retrospective effect is preposterous.

Only when the mode of selection was amended to 50:50 (Direct Recruitment / Promotion) in 07/02/2007 and vacancy was available, Dr. S.P.K. Kennedy Babu was promoted as Professor on 07/02/2007. In the case of Dr. Bikas Jyoti Borthakur, neither retrospective recruitment nor seniority with retrospective effect was given. Hence, drawing parity with Dr. Bikas Jyoti Borthakur for claiming retrospective promotion / recruitment is not proper.

In view of the facts stated above, the request in the representation of Dr. S.P.K. Kennedy Babu, is declined.

ITEM NO.8: DECISION TO FILL UP THE POST OF REGISTRAR AND DEPUTY REGISTRAR FROM AMONG THE SENIOR ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF OF MGPGI

The Board discussed the matter and suggested to fill up post as per existing Recruitment Rule, until then Asst. Registrar (Finance & Accounts) may be given additional charge of Public Information officer (PIO).

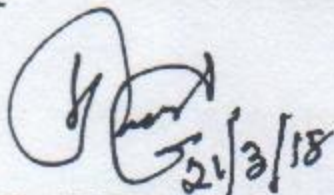


ITEM No. 9: ANY OTHER MATTER WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR.

The Board noted that the tuition fee and other charges levied by MGPGI are quite low.

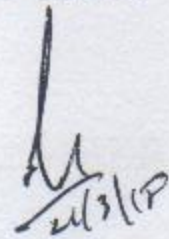
The Board also decided to put up proposals for enhancement of tuition fee and other charges.

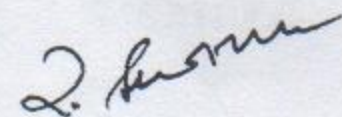

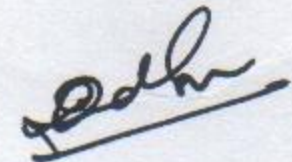

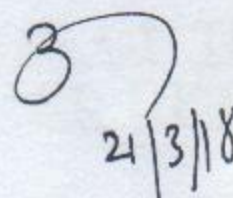
